To: Parents & Guardians of Students Registered to take Dual Credit Courses

Re: New \$50 per course fee from Joliet Junior College

As was published in the Curriculum Guide last spring, we want to remind parents and students that beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, Joliet Junior College will charge a \$50 fee per General Education course. At the beginning of the school year, students will bring home a Registration Form from JJC to be completed, signed by the parent/guardian, and returned to the high school teacher within the first week of school. At that time, the parent will need to follow the directions under the “Parent Acknowledgement” section of the Registration Form to **pay online** for the number of courses the student is registering for. Since students who qualify for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program have the \$50 fee waived, parents will need to know at this time if they qualify for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program.

Students taking Career and Technical courses of “Orientation to Business and Personal Finance” and “Culinary Arts 3” through JJC are free. Students taking “Exploring the Teaching Profession” through University of St. Francis are free also.
