Registration packets were mailed out on June 6th. If you have not already done so, please review, and follow the directions to ensure you submit the required documents. Registration documents must be dropped off or mailed back to PNHS. Please do NOT email any registration documents. Registration forms are due on July 29th.

When dropping your packet off, you can enter the main entrance off 248th, park in the circle drive, and enter the building. The main office is located on the right side as you enter. Please drop your documents off between the following times:

Monday – Wednesday: 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Thursday: 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

All families who have a lease, third party, and/or guardianship must provide proof of residency for the 2022-23 school year by July 29th. These documents are reviewed on a first come basis, so it is beneficial to submit them as early as possible. Please double check the issued dates of the residency proofs before submitting. Residency proofs which do not meet the issued date requirements will not be accepted.

If our registrars do not receive the required documentation by the due date, students will be marked “inactive” until registrars receive, review, and approve the required proofs of residency or registration documents. This procedure is in place at all District 202 schools.

School Fees

School Supplies

There is not a school supplies list for the high school level. Please come prepared with basic materials: folders, notebooks, pens, and pencils. If there are specific items needed by a teacher, they will let the students know. If you are looking to purchase a calculator for math, we recommend the TI 84 Plus by Texas Instruments. This calculator will cover all math classes offered at the high school level.

Physical Education Clothing/Padlocks

There is **NOT** a required uniform for class. Students need to bring appropriate **athletic** clothing/shoes that will allow them to activity participate. The staff will talk more about appropriate clothing requirements over the first couple days. Students can use their school issued padlock from middle school or purchase another one for \$6.00 from their teacher.

Parking Permits Pick-Up

Seniors: August 8th and August 9th from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Juniors: August 10th and August 11th from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. **(Any junior that submitted paperwork but is *not* receiving a permit due to lack of availability will be called prior to August 10th.)**

Students can pick up parking tags during the hours above at their convenience, in the Main Office. All student fees must be paid or be current on a payment plan to purchase and retain a parking permit.
