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1. Class will be run with in the general school policies. No hats, no coats, no gum, etc.
2. **Be prepared** – Come to class prepared. Bring all proper materials needed. (Ex. Books, writing utensils, notebook/paper, homework, etc.)
3. **Respect** – Respect each other’s right to learn. Do not be disruptive in class. (No talking out of turn, no getting out of desks with out permission, etc.) Respect each other’s property. Please do not take anything that does not belong to you.
4. **Absences** – If you are absent, it is YOUR responsibility to find out what you missed (“practice problems,” quiz, or test), and to get the all notes for that day. What we do in class will ALWAYS be posted on **edmodo.com/teacher page on PNHS website**. If you miss a test or a quiz, it is YOUR responsibility to schedule a time to make up the test or quiz. **I WILL NOT REMIND YOU!!!!** If you do not make up the test or a quiz, it will go as a “zero” into the grade book until made up. *****If you miss THE DAY BEFORE THE TEST/QUIZ (review day), you WILL BE TAKING THE TEST/QUIZ on the day it is given.*****
5. **Tardies** – Tardies will be handled with general school policy. (See school handbook). Door will shut promptly as the bell rings.
6. **Passes** – Only THREE passes will be allowed per semester...and you must sign out on the sign out sheet with time in/out and destination. Please...do not ask to leave the classroom during lecture.
7. **Homework** – Make sure to put proper heading on your homework. – date, section, page number, and the problems assigned. Homework is expected to be completed every day. If you do not understand something, please get help. *“The worst thing you can do is NOT try.”* Expect to get homework every day (except on days of tests/quizzes).
8. **Note taking** – Take proper and complete notes. They will be your first resort if you need help with “homework problems.”
9. **Food/Drink** – No food or drink will be allowed in the classroom (unless provided by me.).

GRADING POLICY

Practice: Homework will be checked every 2 to 3 times every chapter (“unit”) with a “Homework Quiz.” These will happen the day after every 2 or 3 sections.

Quizzes: There will be 2-3 quizzes every “unit”. Proper warning will be given before quizzes.

Tests: Tests will be at the end of every unit. For tests and quizzes in which you are allowed to use calculators, the following rules will be enforced.

If you have a TI-83, your calculator’s memory will be cleared prior to the assessment. This will delete ALL programs and games in your calculator. You may reinstall them afterwards. If you don’t want your memory deleted, use another calculator.

If you have a TI-84, your calculator will be put on testing mode prior to the assessment. This will block your access to your programs and games during the test. This will not delete your programs.
